What is this product?

Type: Shares of a Sub-Fund of Amundi Funds, an Undertaking for Collective Investments in Transferable Securities (UCITS), established as a SICAV.

Term: The term of the Sub-Fund is unlimited. The Management Company may terminate the fund by liquidation or merger with another fund in accordance with legal requirements.

Objectives: Seeks to increase the value of your investment (through income and capital growth), and outperform the benchmark, over the recommended holding period, while achieving an ESG score greater than that of its investment universe.

Benchmark: JP Morgan GBI-EM Global Diversified Index. Used for determining financial outperformance and for risk monitoring.

Portfolio holdings: The sub-fund is actively managed. It mainly invests in corporate and government bonds denominated in emerging market currencies.

These investments may be below investment grade. The sub-fund may or may not hedge currency risk at the portfolio level, at the discretion of the investment manager. The sub-fund uses derivatives to reduce various risks (hedging), manage the portfolio more efficiently, and gain exposure (long or short) to various assets, markets or other investment opportunities such as credit, interest rates and foreign exchange.

Management process: In actively managing the sub-fund, the investment manager uses analysis of markets and individual issuers to identify those bonds that appear to offer the best risk-adjusted returns (top-down and bottom-up approach) and may benefit from increases in the value of local currencies. The Sub-Fund is mainly exposed to the issuers of the Benchmark, however, the management of the Sub-Fund is discretionary, and will invest in issuers not included in the Benchmark. The Sub-Fund monitors risk exposure in relation to the Benchmark however the extent of deviation from the Benchmark is expected to be material.

The sub-fund promotes ESG characteristics pursuant to Article 8 of the Disclosure Regulation.

Intended Retail Investor: This product is intended for investors, with a basic knowledge of and no or limited experience of investing in funds seeking to increase the value of their investment and to receive income over the recommended holding period with the ability to bear losses up to the amount invested.

Redemption and Dealing: Shares may be sold (redeemed) as stated in the prospectus at the respective dealing price (net asset value). Further details are provided in the Amundi Funds prospectus.

Distribution Policy: As this is a non-distributing share class, investment income is reinvested.
